CONDITIONAL RELEASE.

(Ticket-of-Leave 14 V. 6, 1850.)

HIS EXCELLENCY THE GOVERNOR has been pleased to authorize me to grant to
Reg. No. 9664, Thomas Berwick _____ who was convicted
of fasting away and destroying a vessel at Central Criminal Court
in Middlesex on the Twenty eighth
day of January 1867 and was then and there sentenced to Penal
Servitude for the term of Twenty years a Conditional Release from
Prison during the remaining portion of his said term of Penal Servitude; unless His
Excellency shall revoke the same under the provisions of any Law or Ordinance in that
case made.

CONDITIONS OF RELEASE.

- 1.—He is not to proceed to either of the newly discovered districts to the North and East.
- 2.—He is to report his place of residence to the senior officer of Police in any district in which he may locate himself.
- 3.—When changing his residence from one place to another, he is to report the same to the senior officer of Police in the district he is leaving, and in that to which he is going.
- 4.—These reports may be made personally, or in writing.

5.—He is to remain subject to summary jurisdiction; and all sentences passed upon him for misconduct, misdemeanor, or any serious offence will be cumulative upon, and in addition to, his original sentences, and on the expiration of his magisterial sentence he will revert to his original sentence, and will not be released except upon the special order of the Governor.
