From His Excellency

To Commander Dume R.M.

Sir,

As it is absolutely neces-
-sary on account of the advan-
-ced season of the Year that
the Sulphur and Parnelia
should proceed to sea without
loss of time - I shall thank
you to let me know the
earliest day the former can
be got ready - and it is
advisable for the good of the
Service that the Sulphur
should carry some Mules
or oxen let me also know
the number she can carry
without absolute inconvenience
