Whereas by the provisions of "The Goldfields Act, 1895" (59 Vic. No. 40) it is enacted that it shall be lawful for the Governor to divide any Goldfield or any part thereof into Districts, and to define the limits of such Districts, and to assign a name or designation thereto, and from time to time to alter, amend, and vary such limits, boundaries and designations: NOW THEREFORE I, Sir, GERARD SMITH, Governor as aforesaid, in exercise of the powers so vested in me, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, with the advice of the Executive Council do hereby declare that that portion of the Pilbarra Goldfield within the Boundaries described hereunder, shall form, and be known



Station G 24 aforesaid, to the Eastern Boundary of the Pilbarra Goldfield: and on the East and South by portions of the Eastern & Southern Boundaries of the Pilbarra Goldfield.
