From Peter Brown Esquire

To Geo. W. Mangles Esq.

Sir

I am directed by the Lieutenant Governor to acquaint you that he has appointed you to act as Superintendent of Government Stock in this Settlement; and to require that you will forthwith take upon yourself the fulfilment of the duties of that office; taking for your guidance therein such Instructions as you may from time to time receive from this Office — In accepting this appointment you are however to understand that no salary will be attached to it until the circumstances of the Settlement shall lead to a more regular establishment of all the offices under Government.
